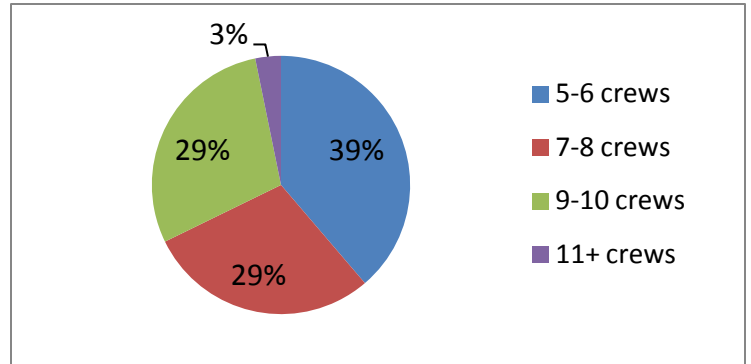
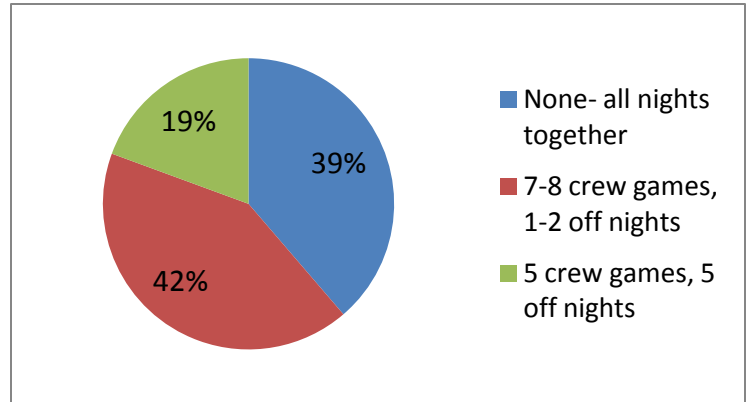


2011 CFOA Survey Results

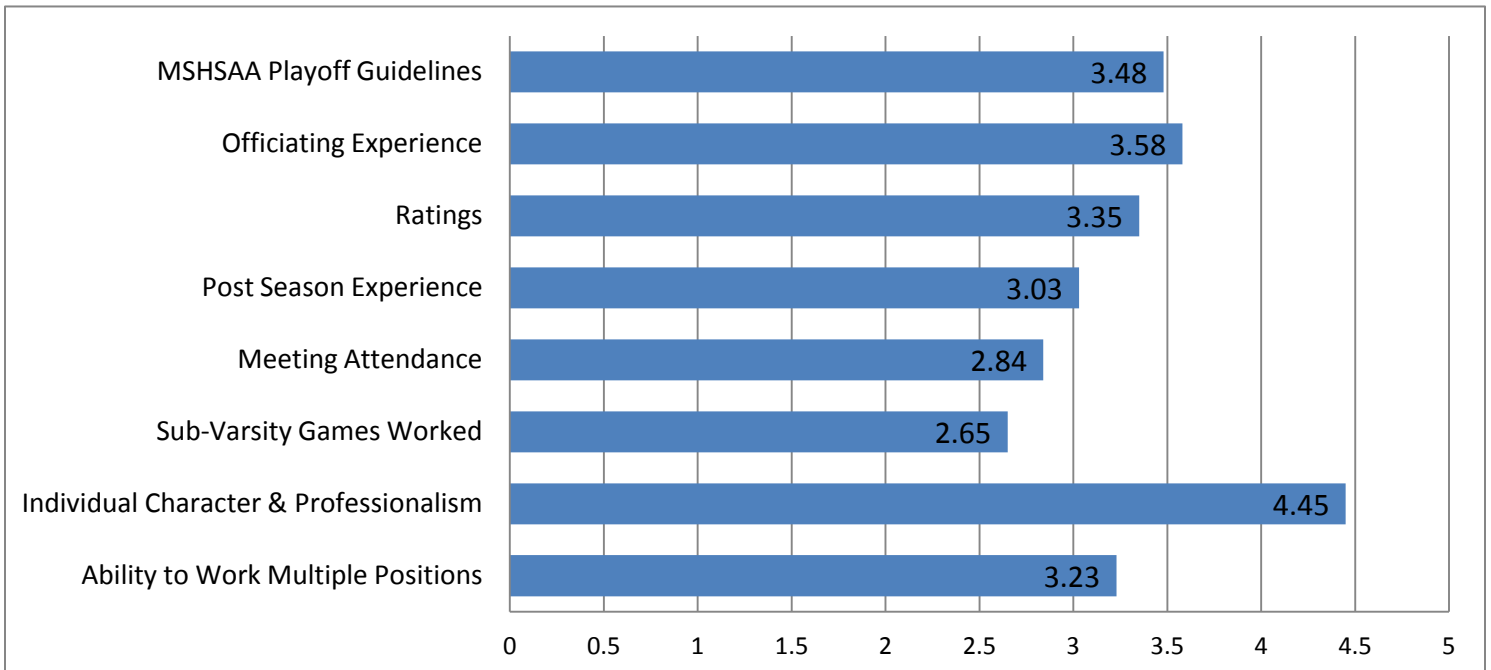

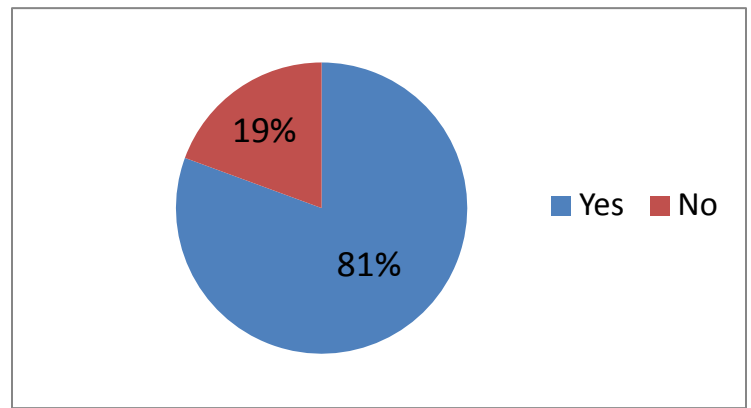
2. Last season, survey results showed a majority of the membership was in favor of working more than 5 games together as a crew. After one season with this set-up, what types of changes if any would you propose?



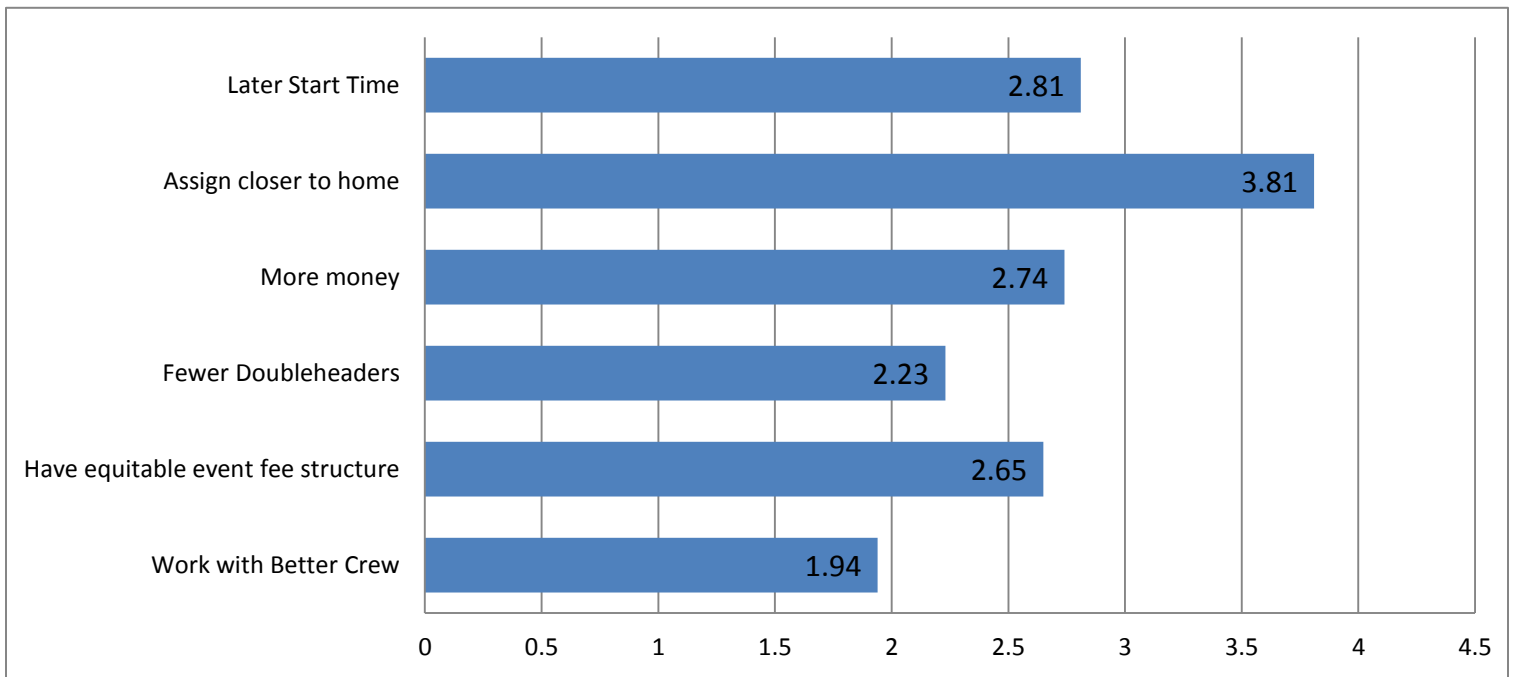
3. How much weight should the crew committee give to each of the following criteria when considering individual assignments for crews?



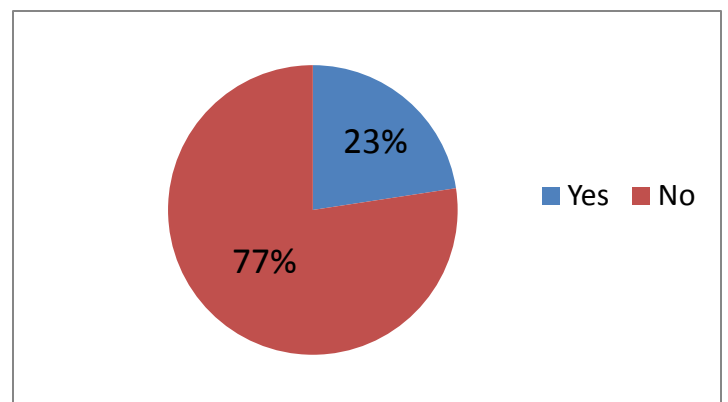
4. If your rating and years of experience excluded you from playoff consideration under MSHSAA's guidelines, would you still be in favor or working on a crew?



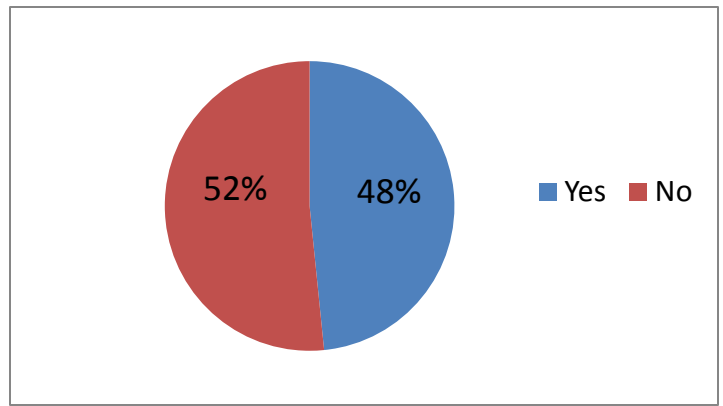

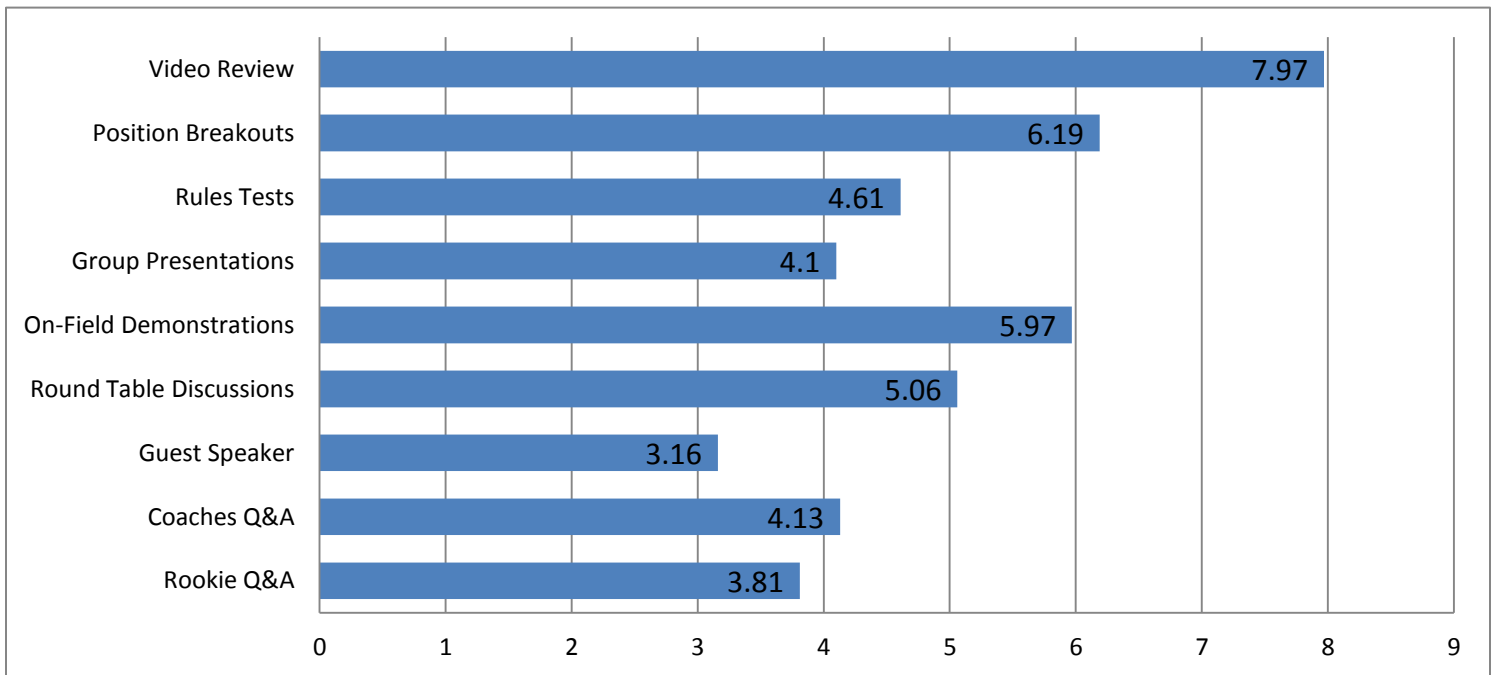
6. Would you be in favor of creating a requirement that officials in their first three years of officiating work youth football at a minimum of three weekends each season?



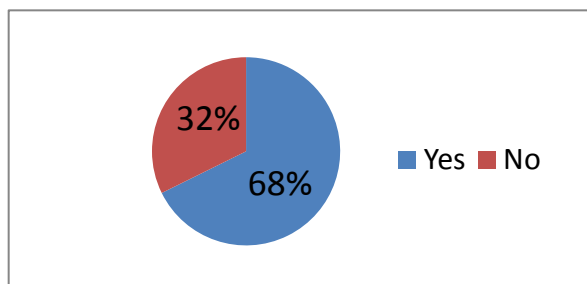
