



# Columbia Football Officials Association

Dear Fellow Official:

It's time again for us to start planning our officiating schedule for the 2012 football season. Please read the entire contents of this letter as it contains some new information from prior years. To help with crew assignments and scheduling, you will need to complete the following forms:

1. 2012 CFOA Membership Registration
2. 2012 CFOA Availability Calendar

The membership form will be used to obtain the information needed to construct the 2012 schedules, please take care in filling it out completely and accurately. **Please ensure you block out any dates on the availability calendar including pre-season and post-season dates. This is vital in determining crews and their eligibility for working post-season assignments.**

On November 3, 2004, the CFOA voted that dues would be \$30.00 for officials with three or fewer years of registration with CFOA and \$55.00 for all other members. **Your dues and membership registrations must be turned in by February 29, 2012. Anyone not having their dues paid by this date shall not be assigned for a crew unless approved by the Executive Committee.**

CFOA will have all crews tentatively assigned by April 1, 2012 so it is imperative that all information is received in a timely manner. Scheduled will be completed by June 1, 2012.

**Please understand that you will not receive game assignments for the 2012 season unless you have dues paid and a membership registration on file prior to Feb. 29, 2012.**
