



## 2012 - MIAA Football Officiating Camps

### Football Officials – High School & College

The MIAA Conference will have two football officiating camps in the spring of 2012. The two camps we had last year not only helped improve the MIAA staff they also helped the Heart of America, Jayhawk Juco, KCAC, and many High School officials improve their officiating skills. Also the camps helped generate a lot of interest in college football officiating. Our goal is to help any high school, or college football official to be the best they can be. Through these camps we are able to generate a list of potential officials that are ready to move to the next level in officiating. Both camps will be informative, educational, with an emphasis on training and helping each official reach their potential. We wanted to have two camps so you would have a choice of dates to attend, as everyone seems to be very busy in the springtime.

**1<sup>st</sup> Camp – March 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, and April 1<sup>st</sup>.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Camp = April 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>**

**Location = Pittsburg, Kansas**

### What will each camp have

Each camp is open to all officials wanting to move to the College level, High School officials wanting to learn more about officiating or officials that are already working College football and want to improve their skills.

1. At both camps we are planning on sending crews out to work scrimmages at several schools. (If they have scrimmages) (If you would rather not work on the field just let me know)
2. Learn how to get and evaluate game film for yourself and your crew.
3. Position break-outs with individual attention and a focus for working that position.
4. Exit interview – One on one, we will help you set goals for the future.
5. The registration fee for each camp is \$200. This includes a notebook, T-Shirt, and three meals (Friday, dinner, Saturday, lunch, and dinner). Each official is responsible for their own lodging. (See hotels below)

4. Several Big 12 officials will help as instructors
5. MIAA officials will also help as instructors
6. We will have at least three instructors for each position (25-30 instructors)
7. We will also have a guest speaker at each camp

### Hotels

**Please do not make reservations at the hotels as I have blocked off rooms for each camp. I will send a list to the hotel for all our rooms.** If you want a single room or if you know who you want for a roommate just send me an email, otherwise I will send the list of campers out to all and then you may pick a roommate. I will need to tell the Hotel's at least two weeks before the camp. You do not have to stay at one of the hotels, if you want to drive in each day or stay with friends that would be OK.

Topeka – Capital City Plaza Hotel - \$69 – Single or Double each night – Free full menu breakfast each day.

Pittsburg – Lamplighter Inn & Suites - \$60 – Single or Double each night – Free continental breakfast each day.

### Registrations

If you just send in your registration you will be on the camp list. However if you send in your registration and payment you will be guaranteed a spot in the camp. If you do not send payment with the registration you will need to send payment for the Topeka camp by March 16, and the Pittsburg camp by April 6<sup>th</sup>. As registrations are received, officials will be assigned a position and a crew to work with. (If you want to work on the field) We will assign you to a position that you select on your registration. If your registration fee and other documents are not received within that time, we will offer that space to the next official on the waiting list. **You will receive an email confirmation when your registration fee is received.
